• Working with the Canadian Association of Women in Construction Committee to develop a "tool book" for women in construction

In the Prairie Arctic Regional Council, Cathy Cayea now co-chairs the **Saskatchewan SIB Committee** with Amanda Leggette. Meetings are scheduled bi-monthly on the third Monday. Members have been working hard to recruit, educate, and connect with Sisters as well as the community.

Some of their recent accomplishments include:

Brought on two new female apprentices

• Have two new journeymen women in 2017

• Have more Sisters attending union meetings – almost equal number men and women

• Had four women in an apprenticeship course – highest level so far

• Attended a "Try a Trade" community event that saw a lot of interest from women

Some of their ongoing initiatives include:

• Suggesting Sisters attend apprenticeship training and skills training

• Encouraging Sisters to join the Council-wide PAC so they can push ideas that support women

• Working with the Building Trades initiative on the "Build TogetHER" project

• Sending out mass emails to share information about the committee and other useful news

• Toledo, Ohio – Local 351: Sisters are planning their first meeting in August 2017.

Western District

In the Pacific Northwest Regional Council, the **Portland SIB Committee** is seeing positive results in the areas of recruitment, retention, education, legislation, and community involvement.

• Helped recruit women at the Oregon Trades Women (OTI) 25th annual career fair

• Spearheaded a float in the Portland Pride Parade - Local 1503 Sisters

• Seen an average of 30 attendees at recent monthly SIB meetings

• Have several Sisters running for office in their Local Union

• Held another successful SIB Leadership class – topic was financial literacy

• Implemented plans to get Local support and funding to send sisters to Chicago Women Build the Nation Conference

• Celebrated the passage of a law that mandates apprentices on state projects – this was a longstanding goal

• Organized a major building project at a new location of R2D2 Houseless Villages

• Planned and designed a trellis and garden bed for auction to support Labor Community Services (LCS)

• Joined LCS on "Paint the Community" projects around town – one Sister organized and completed a project with an all-carpenter crew

• Volunteered with the Carpenters in Action Group (CIA) group to plan and execute the annual Blues Festival fund raiser for Oregon Food Bank
